Bookings for July 2020 open at 8.30am on Friday 1 February 2019.

Pre-Booking Checklist

Before you call, or book online, get the information below ready:

- Locations you are interested in.
It is recommended that you have a preference list (e.g. top 4 locations), in case your top choices are unavailable.
- Check-in and check-out date
- Type of accommodation i.e. view or no view
- Number of bedrooms
- Contact details, including home address, mobile number and email
- Visa or Mastercard details

Bookings can be made:

- Online at rotnnestisland.com;
- Through Reservations on 08 9432 9111; or
- In person at E-Shed, Victoria Quay, Fremantle.

What you need to know:

- You can book online, in person or by phone by accommodation type only. Email bookings will not be actioned.
- Mobility impaired accommodation must be requested in writing, so please email your request to reservations@rotnnestisland.com.
- All bookings must be paid in full at the time of booking and your confirmation advice will be emailed.
- Only two (2) bookings can be made at any one time.
Where a second booking is made on behalf of someone else correct personal details must be provided to Rottnest Island Reservations at least 48 hours prior to arrival - including full name, address, email address & mobile phone number.
- As part of our [booking terms and conditions](#), a credit card pre-authorisation will be requested on arrival.

Important Information:

- Due to planned maintenance Thomson Bay South is unavailable for bookings from early May to late September 2020.
- July School Holiday rates apply from Friday 3 July 2020 to Saturday 18 July 2020.

Booking into August 2020:

If you are arriving towards the end of July and do not wish to depart until the beginning of August please note the following booking restriction; You must stay at least the last 5 nights in July 2020 to book up to the first 3 nights in August 2020. Therefore you must arrive no later than Monday 27 July 2020 and depart no later than Tuesday 4 August 2020. Shortening of the July dates is not permitted.
