

# Rottnest Island August 2022 Booking Guide

Bookings open 8:30am Wednesday 1 December 2021

Whether you're ready to return for your annual island holiday or you're dipping your toes into these sparkling waters for the first time, we can't wait to welcome you to Wadjemup / Rottnest Island.

# Your island adventure

Bookings for August 2022 will open on Wednesday 1 December 2021 at 8:30am AWST.

This step-by-step guide is filled with expert tips and tricks to help you through the booking process ahead of Open Day.

## Where to go to book

**In general, over 80% of successful bookings are made online within the first 30 minutes of an Open Day, so we recommend booking online.**

While you can also book by calling our reservations team on **1800 111 111** or visiting us at our office at E Shed, Fremantle or the Visitor Centre on the island, the simplest and most successful way is via the website at [rotnnestisland.com](https://rotnnestisland.com). The online queue also moves a lot faster than the phone lines.

Please understand that demand for bookings may be high and not everyone will be able to secure a reservation.



## Before you book

You're making a list and checking it twice. Make sure you have all the below information to hand before you join the queue:

- ✓ **Where you want to stay.** Make a list of your top four choices, in case number one isn't available.
- ✓ **When you want to stay** (your check-in and check-out dates).
- ✓ **What type of accommodation you want.** Do you want an ocean view?
- ✓ **How many of you there are.** How many bedrooms do you need?
- ✓ **Your contact details** including your address, email address, phone number, and email.
- ✓ **Your Visa or Mastercard details.** We don't take Amex or Diners Cards, so put these away for now.

## Ready to go? Here's how it's done.

1. Head to [rotnnestisland.com](https://rotnnestisland.com) by 8:30am AWST on Wednesday 1 December 2021. A tip: anyone in the virtual waiting room prior to 8:30am will be assigned a random position in the queue when bookings open, whether they joined at 6am or 8:25am. But, if you join after 8:30am, you'll join at the back of the queue.
2. Wait your turn, but don't walk away from your device. Even if your queue number feels high, you'll be surprised how fast it can move.
3. When it's your turn to book, you'll have 10 minutes to enter the booking site. If you don't enter within 10 minutes, you'll have to join the back of the queue. This just helps keep the line moving for everyone else waiting.
4. Once you're in, simply search for your accommodation and make your booking. You can take as long as you like without being kicked off the site if you are actively using it; but remember – places fill fast and your booking is not confirmed until your payment details have been authorised.
5. You can book up to two units of the same type and size per online transaction. If you want to book more units, you'll need to join the queue again. Remember, you'll need to change the name of these bookings to someone staying in the unit before arrival.



## Booking for accessibility

If you need accessible accommodation, please send your request after 8:30am to [reservations@rotnnestisland.com](mailto:reservations@rotnnestisland.com) and don't forget to attach a copy of your ACROD Card (front and back). These requests are processed in the order they're received from 8:30am onwards on Open Day, so hold your email until then.

# Pencil these dates in your diary

## Booking into September 2022:

If you are arriving towards the end of August and do not wish to depart until the beginning of September please note the following booking restriction; You must stay at least the last 5 nights in August 2022 to book up to the first 3 nights in September 2022. Therefore, you must arrive no later than Saturday 27 August 2022 and depart no later than Sunday 4 September 2022. Shortening of the August dates is not permitted.

## On that note ...

All Saturdays have a minimum two-night stay requirement, so you'll need to add either a Friday or Sunday to see any availability when you're searching online.

### Important Information:

Thomson Bay South, Geordie, Longreach and Fay's Bay accommodation is unavailable to book for August 2022.

## Here's what else you need to know

**You can book online, by phone or in person.** Email requests will only be processed for accessible bookings.

**You can book up to two units of the same type and size per online transaction** however you can only be a registered guest for one accommodation at a time and must be staying in the unit for the duration of the stay.

**If you book a second unit in the same transaction** against your name, you will then have to change the registered guest name for the second unit before check-in.

**If you're booking on behalf of someone else,** correct personal details must be provided to Rottnest Reservations at least 48 hours prior to arrival including full name, address, email address, and phone number.

**You can request specific unit numbers** when booking and we'll do our best to accommodate them, but your unit number won't be assigned until approximately three weeks before you arrive.

**All self-contained bookings must pay a 25% deposit** at time of booking, with the balance due 30 days prior to arrival. Campground and Hostel bookings require payment in full at time of booking.

**A credit card pre-authorisation** will be requested on your arrival.

Want to change the configuration of beds or hire additional items?

Please contact Reservations at least seven days prior to arrival on **1800 111 111**.

# Take it from us

To give yourself the very best chance at success, book online and make sure you go to the website before 8:30am to be assigned your randomised queue number. Remember, if you arrive after 8:30am, you'll be at the back of the queue.

## Hot tip

Go to [rotnnestisland.com](https://rotnnestisland.com) now and play around on the online booking site. That way when Open Day rolls around you'll be familiar with the screens and all the information you'll need.

## Put pen to paper

Write down what you want, as well as some back-up options. If you want to stay somewhere in particular, make note of the date ranges you're able to work with. If your dates aren't flexible, jot down some alternate accommodation or room options. There's a lot of pressure on the day to be quick, so having it all in front of you is always helpful.

## Time to cool off

Try for your number one choice first and work backwards from there. There's a 14-day cooling off period if you need to change your booking and here's another tip: if you're not sure, it's a lot easier to reduce your number of nights later than to add on more.

## What goes around comes around

Here's another tip for you ... there's a little unspoken karma at play on Open Days. So, like all good things, only take as much as you need. Occasionally we hear of someone booking more than they need, only to dump it later – and in the meantime, so many others miss out. Only book what you need, and we promise the karma will be kind.

## Missed out?

As much as we'd love to have all of you, we just can't host everyone at the same time. But awe and wonder aren't seasonal.

Beyond the beaches, spectacular events go by near unnoticed. From playful seals and stunning bird migrations to traditional smoking ceremonies and more, there's a whole other side to the island waiting to be discovered.

From May to early July, the island's Traditional Owners celebrate the arrival of Djeran and Makuru, two of the Noongar calendar's six seasons.

When spring arrives in September, the island plays host to the annual birthday celebration for the quokkas, as the joeys start to leave their mothers' pouches for the first time. You'll also have a chance to see the world's greatest dance performance as thousands of acrobatic humpback whales make their way north.

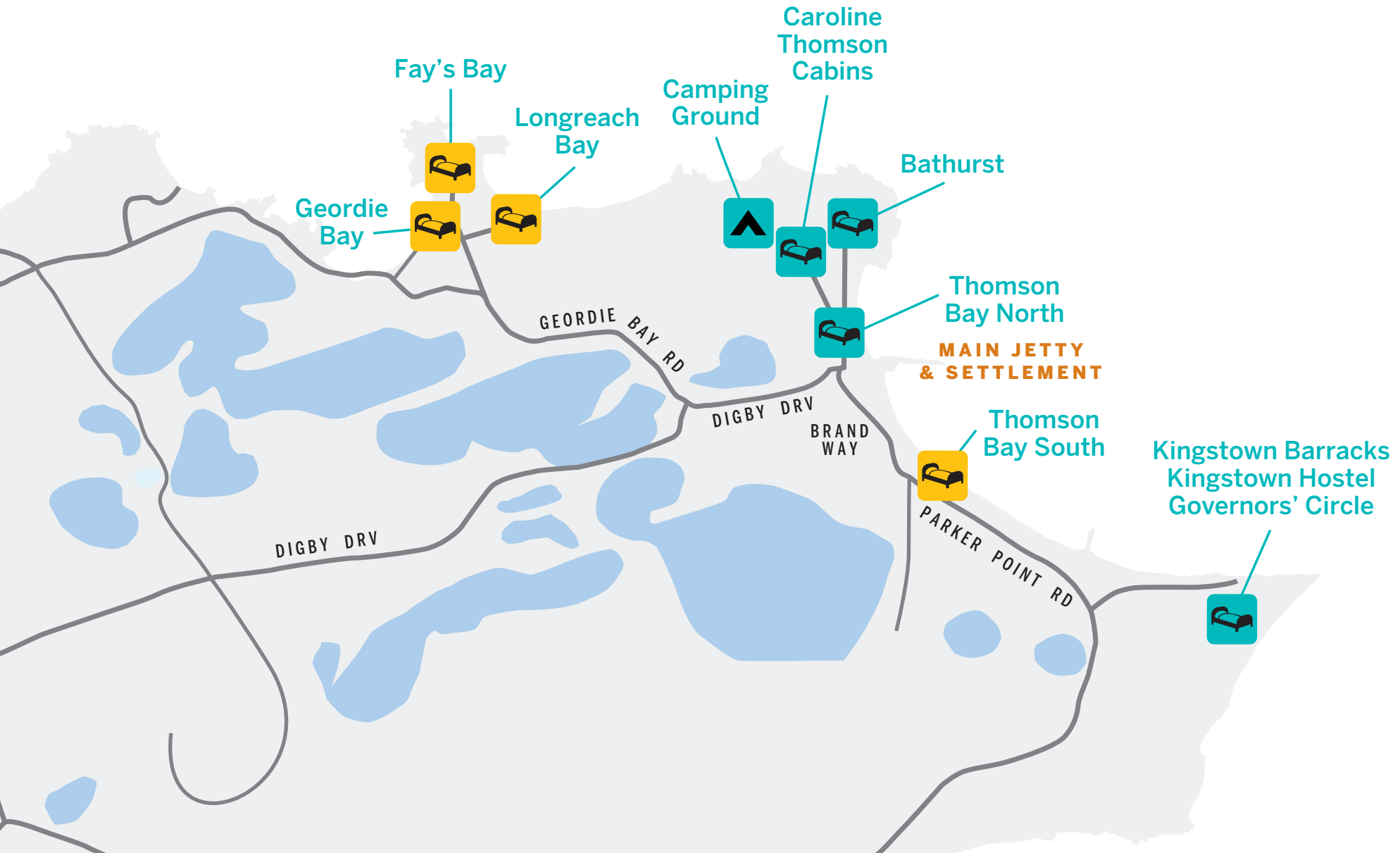

## Terms and conditions of booking

### 1. Bookings

May be transferred to another registered guest with at least 24 hours written notice. The registered guest must be over 18 years of age and spend each night in the accommodation for the duration of the booking. Photo identification and a valid credit card will be required when the key is collected. Information relating to bookings will not be released to a third party under any circumstances.

Bookings with a balance owing require final payment no less than 30 days prior to the date of arrival. Unless advised otherwise, the Rottnest Island Authority will automatically charge the card on file the balance owing, and the customer approves the charge.

### 2. Alterations and Cancellations

- a) Written or email notice of alterations and cancellations must be provided for all bookings except for those cancelled in person in which case appropriate identification will be required.
- b) Where booking dates are amended within 30 days of arrival, standard cancellation fees will apply. Any change to a booking less than 48 hours prior to arrival will result in full cancellation fee. If booking dates are changed more than 30 days prior to arrival and the value of the booking is reduced, standard cancellation fees will apply.
- c) During Holiday Peak periods (eg Summer and Easter holidays), shortening of a booking is not permitted.
- d) Where the booking dates are cancelled in part or full, the following fees will apply dependant on notice provided;
  - More than 30 days prior to arrival: \$55 fixed charge or 50% of the cost of the first night of the stay (whichever is the lowest) will be retained.
  - 3 - 30 days prior to arrival: 100% of the cost of the first night of the stay will be retained.
  - Less than 48 hours prior to 2pm check-in time: Full payment will be retained.
- e) If government restrictions do not allow for a guest to physically travel to the island, applicable bookings may be transferred to an alternative date (subject to availability) without the application of transfer or cancellation fees. If applicable guests do not wish, or are unable, to transfer their booking to another available date, a 100% refund will be made of the deposit paid. Please note that this does not apply if guests change their mind or choose not to visit the island, where normal cancellation charges will apply.

### 3. Relocation

Under exceptional circumstances the Rottnest Island Authority reserves the right to relocate a booking to a suitable alternative of similar type.

### 4. Credit Card Surety

It is a condition of tenancy that the occupant provides a valid credit card preauthorisation to the Rottnest Island Authority and agrees to allow any cost for which they are liable under the tenancy to be levied against this credit card. Security deposits are required during certain periods.

### 5. Occupancy Limits

Tents: Maximum two tents per site with a maximum total of 6 people per site.

Governors' Circle, Caroline Thomson Cabins, Kingstown Dormitories and Hostel: Only 1 person per bed. Additional beds are not available.

Premium Units, Villas and Cottages: Maximum of 1 person per fixed bed plus 50% (e.g. in a 4 bed unit, the number of occupants must not exceed 6).

The Rottnest Island Authority reserves the right to adjust occupancy limits during specified periods.

### 6. Quiet Times

All visitors are required to respect the rights of others to enjoy the island at all times and to observe a "quiet" time of 11pm - 7am in all areas, except:

- Kingstown and Governors' Circle: "Quiet" time of 9pm - 9am applies.
- Camping Ground: "Quiet" time of 9pm - 7am applies.

### 7. Breach of Terms and Conditions

Any breach of the terms and conditions by the registered guest or other occupants may result in immediate cancellation of the tenancy without refund. Additional terms and conditions are located on the reverse of the registration card which must be signed on check-in.

### 8. The 5/3 Booking Rule

When booking in advance and into a closed month, at least 5 nights must be booked in the open month to be able to book a maximum of 3 nights in the closed month. Subsequent shortening of the stay by reducing the number of nights in the open month is not permitted.

### 9. Perth & Peel Stay at Home / Lockdown Directions

In the event of the WA State Government issuing emergency directions for people in the Perth and Peel region to Stay at Home and Lockdown, the Rottnest Island Authority may close its accommodation to guests. In these circumstances guests will be required to return to the mainland as soon as possible. They will receive a 100% refund for any unused period of their stay.
